

## **Directions to the Boeing Renton Technical Library**

### **From the University:**

From the University, the easiest route is to cross the Evergreen Point Bridge and head south on I-405. Go through Bellevue and the Factoria interchange (where I-405 crosses I-90). Continue south until Exit 5 (Park Avenue). Come down the ramp and turn right at the signal light; then proceed down the hill to Park Avenue.

### **From Downtown Seattle:**

From downtown Seattle, take I-90 across Lake Washington. At the intersection with I-405, take the southbound ramp for Renton. Continue south on I-405 until Exit 5 (Park Avenue). Come down the ramp and turn right at the signal light; then proceed down the hill to Park Avenue.

### **From the Airport:**

From the Pacific Highway South, enter I-405 North. Follow I-405 past Southcenter to Renton. Take Exit 5 (Park Avenue). Come down the ramp and turn left at the signal light; then proceed down the hill to Park Avenue.

### **From Bellevue:**

Take I-405 southbound toward Renton. Take Exit 5 (Park Avenue). Come down the ramp and turn right at the signal light; then proceed down the hill to Park Avenue.

### **Further Instructions:**

Proceed south on Park Avenue. You will be surrounded on both sides by Boeing buildings. AT the signal light at North 6<sup>th</sup>, you will see a high rise building (7 floors). That is the Engineering Center for the Boeing Commercial Airplane Group. Turn left at that intersection and go one block to Garden. Turn right on Garden, then turn right again into a driveway directly in back of the Engineering Center. Turn left into the first driveway of the parking garage. Follow that lane to the end and turn right. Then start looking for a parking place. The library is on the first floor of the 10-13 building directly to the west of the parking garage and directly south of the Engineering Center. You will want to park as close as you can to the west.

Once you arrive, you will need a visitor's pass, which is available in the lobby of the Engineering Center. However, it is probably easier to come to the door of the library and call 237-8311 for access. The door is locked and has a badge reader. We will take you to the visitor's lobby.
