

# Information about the Presentation Stage of Accelerated Learning:

Old style - presentation is usually the only phase attended to when designing a program. It is often 100% instructor.

New style -- Presentation is 20% of the entire learning cycle.

Therefore, to be 20% there needs to be a different process...

It's about:

- encountering the new
- having an experience
- taking in visual, auditory, and tactile data

So you:

- appeal to all learning styles
- stimulate all the senses
- engage the whole brain of participants, and
- encourage on-going collaboration

Through:

- colorful graphics
- interesting objects and presentation aids
- wall, floor, ceiling, and table-top peripherals
- metaphors and analogies
- appeal to the image brain
- movement
- using people as "props"
- visual, auditory and tactile stimulation
- partnered and team learning projects
- music
- interactive presentations
- partner and team-based learning projects
- discovery exercises
- problem solving exercises

The new style "Presentation Phase: of Accelerated Learning (20% of total) is then divided into 30% facilitator and 70% student!
