






Like many fellow artists, we have made Bainbridge Island our home and our permanent studio location since 1977. We create leaded & stained glass windows for residential, commercial, & liturgical clients, teach glass classes in a variety of techniques, work with art teachers & students on school installations, and still recently owned and operated a gallery in the Pike Place Market neighborhood. Our expertise encompasses the design & fabrication of new windows as well as the restoration of windows and lamps from eras past. We currently produce a line of leaded glass chandeliers that we sell nationally and are presently learning & improving the technique of lamp working.

What brings us to display at the Bainbridge Library is our involvement with an art class at Woodland Middle School where we, in consultation with art teacher, Dany Hernt engaged 5th graders in a leaded glass project designed for the ballroom of the Children's Library. Our project was a small part of an extensive effort spearheaded by artist, Michele Van Slyke. Funded through private donations & the library's remodeling budget, Michele's vision to include art in our library in decorative & functional ways, became a reality.

The glass tile project is titled "Class-Abec". Each child was given a letter and an array of glass pieces & colors for them to create a letter of the alphabet by the method of collage. The design and character of the letter was left to their creativity. A visit to the children's library downstairs will enhance your visit to the library.
