


RDA Implemented March, 2013


Why???

- AACR2 written in context of card catalog
- Rules increasingly complex but inadequate for new types of resources
- No theoretical framework to act as reference when dealing with new situation
- Not enough support for collocation
- Anglo-American centric

Functional Requirements for Bibliographic Records







Why the fuss?

- Headings – official form of a name or uniform title which is used in the record so that all works by that person or corporate body or all works which have been given that uniform title will be gathered together.
- Some are changing with RDA

- Wrede, Patricia, 1953- , author 1 record

What next???


- Have been using MARC since 1970s
